

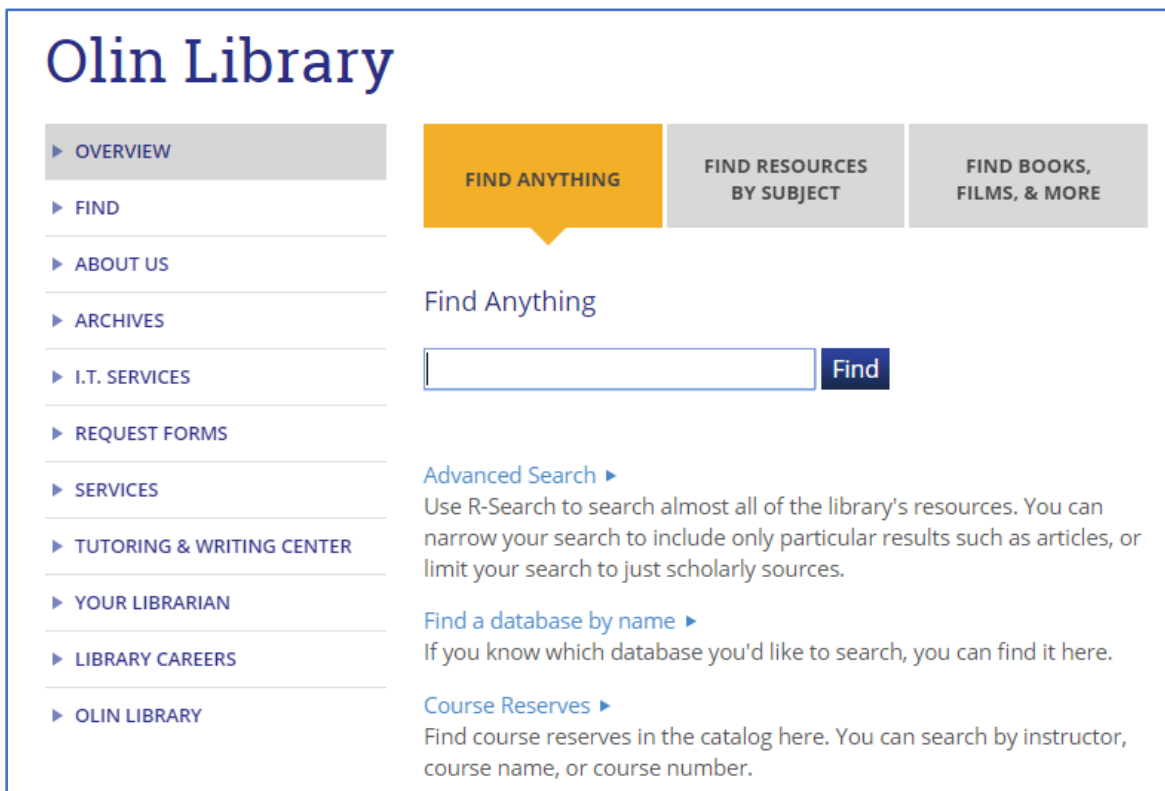
## Using WordCat And ILL to Find Exhibition Catalogs

**WorldCat** – shorthand for “World Catalog,” – is the mother-of-all-databases that allows you to find ANYTHING in collections worldwide! So, try it out! I guarantee you’ll find what you’re looking for!

So, if Rollins doesn’t have the exhibition catalog you’re looking for (and we may not!), use WorldCat to find it and then you can use **Interlibrary Loan (ILL)** to have it sent directly to you. [Warning: this is not an overnight process. It could take up to a week for you to receive you requested item through ILL. Plan ahead appropriately!].

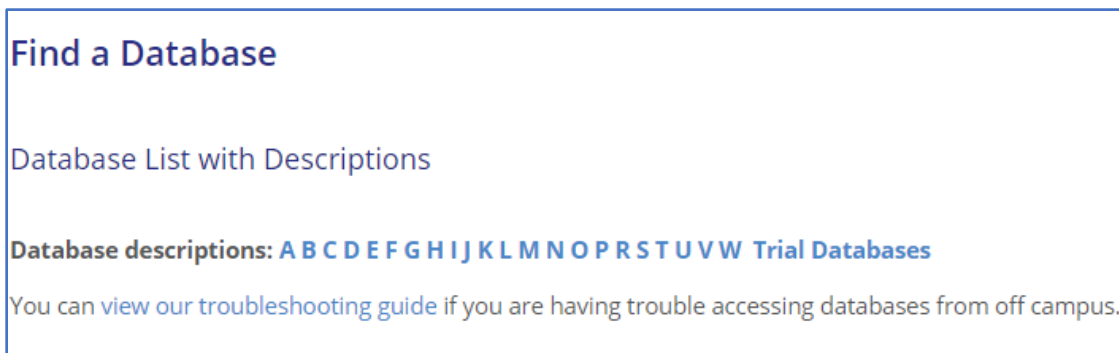
### How to find the WorldCat database:

**Step 1)** Go to the Olin Library website (<http://www.rollins.edu/library/>)

**Step 2)** Select “**Find a database by name**” to be taken to an alphabetic listing of all our databases. Choose “**W**” at the top of the page.

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**Step 3)** When you see all the “W” database listings, select “**WorldCat Local**” to be taken to the main WorldCat search box.

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## How to request the item using Interlibrary Loan (ILL):

**Step 1)** Do your search and add “exhibition” at the end. Also, limit by “Book” so that you can narrow down your search results.

**Step 2)** Select the exhibition catalog of choice from the search results. (Screenshot on following page). Then, when you click through to the item, click the **plus sign** next to “**Worldwide Libraries that own this item**” to see where the closest copy is held.

Tip -- If Rollins has a copy that will be noted in **green** under “libraries that own this item.”

Tip -- If you scroll down you can confirm that what you are looking at is an exhibition catalog under the “**Details**” header next to “**Genre/Form.**”

**Step 4)** If you are signed in all the information from your selection will automatically populate in the proper fields. You simply need to scroll down and select **“Submit Request.”** You will receive an email notification to your Rollins email address when your item is ready to be picked up from the Olin Library circulation desk.
