Assignment 2- Mixing Traditional and Digital Images + using Masks and Layers

This project is designed to learn the multiple functions of the software Photoshop. These compositions will contain multiple layers which will form a single image. Grading will be based on the sophisticated use of masks and layers and the composition as a whole.

Part 1: Design 3 compositions using traditional media (pencil, pen & ink, paint, collage mix and match anything!). These compositions should be no smaller than 8" x 10". Due date
Part 2: scan your compositions into Photoshop at 300dpi. Manipulate the images by adding new elements, playing with filters, changing colors etc. (on separate layers). Once you have finished to yours and my satisfaction, print out two copies (turn in 1 copy plus original scanned image) Due date
Part 3: on printed image from part 2, add new elements to your image. This should be done using traditional drawing/painting medium. NOTHING WET OR TACKY SHOULD BE PLACED IN THE SCANNER!!! Due date
Part 4: scan your image from part 3 (as you did in part 2). Make three different files of the same image. Work all three files in Photoshop, adding new elements to each image that are different again on a new layer. Print out copies of each image. Due date
Part 5: pick which altered image you feel to be the strongest. Create 3 version of that image which are different but have a uniform consistency. Due date
